



Note the extended great toe and the ridge of substrate material behind the other toes. This is in keeping with normal human footprints made in stride as predicted by Godfrey. When excavated the depression along the outside of the print was slightly deeper than the inside arch area. This too is as would be predicted in normal human locomotion.

Bauanthropus I print excavated by our team shown in situ (top photo) and in cast (lower photo). Note slight "bulge" at the lateral base of the fifth metatarsal area. This is specifically Homo sapiens in foot contour.
