

In letting factual data speak for itself the plausibility and factuality of human habitation in Cretaceous reference has been demonstrated. Such interpretation which breaks with academic preference must, of necessity, be strapped with rigorous guidelines. These guidelines have been accepted and have been followed. Hopefully, the results will be accepted as readily.

Since early stages of the excavations, the individuals making the tracks have been called Humanus bauanthropus. Individual trackways or isolated footprints of the same size and characteristics have been designated by common names within the Bauanthropus subclassification: Bauanthropus I (16" prints), Clark (14" prints), Sir George (11.5" prints), Beverly (9.75" prints), Becky (5" prints), and Max (22" prints).

Bau was selected because of a physically superior royal tribe in Fiji. Sir George is their revered modern leader.

The introduction of their classification is as follows:

ORDER Primates

SUBORDER Anthropeida (higher primates)

SUPERFAMILY Hominoidea (hominoids)

FAMILY Hominidae (hominids)

GENUS Homo (man)

SPECIES Homo sapiens (intelligent man)

SUBSPECIES Homo sapiens humanus (superior intelligent man)

SUBSAPIENS CLASSIFICATION Homo humanus bauanthropus
(distinctive superior man)

This addition to the classification of man is justified, for the evidence demonstrates that man did walk with dinosaurs.
