Interview - Jacob Mc Fall 8-18-69

Age 44, Lived here since childhood, Born 1 mi. N
 Catfish up to 30th, Caught 8-10th fish.
 Dug out 1 man track. 30-35 dms. in the 1950s
 People not interested in man tracks.
 Trax sold to stores mostly. \$20 to \$250
 Takes 1-2 wks to dig 1 out if layer is 18" thick.
 If 6-8" thick doesn't take long.

Track
 1 track had dms & man close together 8-10" apart.
 Some direction? Don't recall

In pot hole behind school - Ryals dug it out.

Jack dug out 1st man track that was dug out 1934
 Just a boy. Daddy helped. Sold it.

Joe marks "real plain" size of a 6'6" man's foot
 Smaller than most.

Old ones erode, New ones turn up from time to time
 Submerged trax hold up longer, unless something hits em.
 Freezes up on bank & gets hot.

Dug up 2 trax in 1 day, rock 4" deep. They are over at
 Clebourne at a scowling of a rock. Still there. Don't
 know many man trax dug up. Not too many anyway. Prob
 lots here if we could locate them.

3 sets of trax down at coffee dam
 Won't last long. 1st big flood will ^{scour them up}
 River rises in 2 hrs to bottom bank ^{10-12 feet}. Has risen 20-21 ft
 Flood control has changed things. Since 23 ft, 1958
 Cattle, timber 732 acres. 30+ cattle now.
