Field notes

10:25 am, 8-18-69, Monday. Nujel replica, diara, rather small.
Set of 3 diara tracks, emerging fr. river & going eastward.
Stride - 4-3"

Pointer points to big hind track, going eastward.
Heel of big track touches a little track
all 1/2 ft above water level on narrow ledge,
3 1/2 ft from water's edge.

Water temp - 82°

Small animal going S. S.W.

15 tracks counted, considered to be diara track.
Course is gently circular going S. S.E., then
turning to south.

11:30 am

1 small nujel replica, 12 oz. nujel, 30 oz water

2nd project.

10 ft above H₂O on So. bank, flat rock-ledge.
River flows east. Water 1-2 ft deep. Series of
sharp rocky ledges. Top ledge level for several
hundred feet & nearly as smooth as a pavement.
Dips slightly southward, hence a little water
between us & the mud bank to the south.

Casted what had similarity of a human left foot.
Subject to interpretation. Taking imprint for
further study.

Jeltrate, 6 oz c 15 oz water
