

The photo on the following page displays the Burdick print in the Cretaceous rock matrix after current sectioning. Sectioning was done by professional lapidarist Cordel Van House in the presence of this researcher and co-researcher Don Patton. Geologist Don Patton and this researcher have identified a Cretaceous rock layer identical to the Burdick print matrix in Cross Branch, a Somerville County tributary to the Paluxy River. Lapidarist Cordel Van House has verified the internal microstructure and inclusions of the Cross Branch layer to be identical to the matrix of the Burdick print.
