Length? 17-18" Wide 4-5 1/2" at toes.  
Other tracks? Yes. Stride - 3 ft to 6 ft.  
Average 5' stride.

Quite a lot of these tracks at that time,  
On Mc Fall farm. On so. bank of river  
but on N. boundary of Mc Fall farm.

Dr. Cook had it in yard, in the grass. Later it

Track had decayed last time he saw it. "shivered off"

B-2 Size of ~~tracks~~ rocks cut out? 2 ft, some smaller.  
Allowed 4-6" border. Soft rock.

Many tracks ruined. Water cut 'em.

How many man traps cut out? 8 or 10  
Many dino traps.

Mrs. Ryals hammered, he ~~to~~ held chisel.

1 to 3 days or a week to cut out a track.

Cut channel 4-6" wide around print:

to 5-6" below print. Made his own chisel.

Put big iron band, slipped away down.

Thousands of tracks have been ruined.

Band tightened & hit.

~~To~~ Undercut them to chisel, 3-4"

Then would snap off. Then hooked in a steam, turned  
Track weight 5-6-700 lb. Used a chain.
