

② In track I examined, the big the print was not quite definite. There's where plaster in a cell phone box (a good big one to do a 15" x 7" x 7") comes in. If you use plaster of Paris it will set up faster (8-10 min) than builders' plaster - pretty like difference so it will mold into the depression. It should dry fast OK, then within any help since it is heavy & the cure is not swift.

③ Ask at roadside near both. Have Mr. Marshall show you the line track near a messroom track. (2 mud block numbers they are cleaned out.) Clean 'em out - water + scrub them, etc. Get a plaster cast (surgical plaster) if possible after a clean out job. If this goes out the way I would it, you'll have a messroom + a dining room. If this goes out the same level, dining print is north of the mess print. 2 feet apart, more going east. I think this is about the middle of dining going west, more going east. This needs to be checked out carefully before the 11 more series. This needs to be checked out carefully before putting much emphasis on it, I must have a not convincing enough.

Also -

- ① Anne needs 2 copies of each photo of Campbell's site
 2 Xerox's of each article
 2 of photos of the print track. If you can print it out at exact size + label it as such, it would help.

Also supply Anne with 2 of each in plaster I did for Tiger + man. Ken Foster, Dr. Evans, is interested. (Also Floyd Brumfield) + J. Walker. Evans is covered already so it is not a problem from Anne for use with printing people. I will come to keep the other set of 2 copies + not loan 'em out. (1 banner is enough.)
